The leading causes of these deaths include fires, burns, drowning, firearms, falls, choking, and poisoning. For infants under 1 year old, however, suffocation is the top cause of injury-related death. This makes it even more crucial for anyone with a baby at home to take steps this month to enhance their home's safety.
